ON2R PRODUCTIONS – groove dragon

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS. *(Provided and paid for by Purchaser)*

EACH OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IS REQUESTED TO PROVIDE THE SMOOTHEST SHOW POSSIBLE:

A. Dressing Room. Two (2) clean, heated and air-conditioned (climate controlled) private dressing rooms, (one of which shall be the venue's prime quite dressing room) shall be provided for use by Artist. Each shall contain a full-length mirror, a sink with hot and cold running water, private toilet facilities, a steam iron and ironing board and one 20 amp electrical circuit. Rooms must be lockable, with keys provided to Artist designated representative. Should have adequate power plugs, hi-speed internet connection. Purchaser shall station security personnel sufficient to ensure the safety of Artist, Artist's employees, their instruments, clothing, and personal property at doors of dressing rooms from 30 minutes before Artist's arrival until after Artist leaves the building following each performance. Artist's dressing room shall not be available for use by union or other stage crews, or anyone other than Artist.

B. Each dressing room shall be equipped with the following:

- Box Kleenex
- Bar Soap
- 1 bottle of Purell or other hand-sanitizer
- Iron & ironing board or separate wardrobe facilities
- Comfortable upholstered sofa & chairs, rugs
- **Plastic cups, napkins, plenty ice for drinks, bottle opener, wine key, garbage cans**

C. Dressing Room Food:

- One (1) Premium Deli-Tray(Boar's Head Brand) and One (1) Fruit Tray shall be provided in the dressing room to feed Twelve (12) people and is intended for the **BAND** and **CREW ONLY**. The tray should consist of several meats and cheeses, vegetables (lettuce, tomato, etc.)a selection of condiments, banana peppers, pickles, olive oil, vinegar, salt , pepper, plates, utensils and napkins, paper towels.
- One (1) loaf of Whole Wheat bread.
- One (1) bag 6 rolls
- One (1) can of Mixed Nuts.
- One (1) pound bag of M & M's Peanut candies.
- One (1) qt. orange juice
- One (1) qt. Ocean spray cranberry juice
- One (1) 750 ml Patron Silver Tequila
- Two (2) dozen 16oz Solo plastic cups
- Twenty (20) 20lbs cubed ice for drinks
- Hot coffee or tea both caffeinated and regular
- Twelve (12) bottles Mike's Hard Lemonade (berry preferred, regular or cranberry okay—no diet!)
- Twenty Four (24) Bottles of Beer (Coors Lite, Local brewed, Corona etc.)

D. Stage Drinks: to be placed in production office 1 hour prior to show time

- Six (6) 16oz bottles Evian water or other quality spring water
- Six (6) dark hand towels for use on stage
- One (6) dozen 16oz Solo plastic cups

E. Meal Requirements:

For (8-10) band and crew at a time to be determined by the production manager. Please provide a quiet, pleasant atmosphere with cloth napkins and tablecloths, china and silverware, water glasses, ceramic coffee cups or mugs. **No Styrofoam, please.**

The Band/Crew meal shall consist of a hot, well balanced (meat, vegetables, etc.) meal. No fried bar appetizers/sandwiches/pizza. If purchaser cannot or chooses not to provide a hot meal, purchaser has the option of a meal “buyout” of Twenty Five (**\$28.00**) dollars per band / crew member, to be paid at the time of meal.

EXAMPLES:

- Hot Soup
- Salad w/various dressings
- Warm bread or rolls
- Hot main entree to be confirmed with artist's production manager.
- Two hot vegetable dishes
- Dessert
- Spring water
- Assorted Sodas (Coke Classic, Diet Mtn Dew, Squirt/Mountain Dew, Dr Pepper)
- Assorted Snapple Juice Drinks
- Milk (whole and skim)
- Iced tea (unsweetened)
- Hot tea w/cream, sugar , honey lemon
- Hot coffee w/cream, sugar
- All cold drinks to be refrigerated or iced in coolers

Note: All meals to be served on china, hot and fresh. All meals to be approved during production advance.

F. Towels & Showers. Purchaser shall provide six (6) clean, pre- washed, lint-free towels for use by Artist. **(NO BAR TOWELS, PLEASE)**

G. Secured Parking. Secured parking (commencing with eight hours prior to performance until two hours after performance) is required adjacent to the backstage entrance. Purchaser shall furnish free parking passes, if required.

H. Guests. Artists' representative shall be provided with ten (10) pair of complimentary tickets/seats per show. In the event that the venues uses table seating, Artist shall have the right to reserve table(s) for invited guests or VIPs'. Tickets must be "preferred" seating. Artists' representative will provide a list of guests immediately after sound check, unless otherwise arranged in advance. Purchaser shall not release these tickets until guest list is received, unless otherwise arranged in advance.

I. MEET AND GREETINGS.

Meet and Greets are scheduled typically before the performance.

- Security is requested on any Meet and Greet over 10 people.
- A Quiet designated area is needed, away from General Public
- Tour manager will inform Venue Representative of any Meet and Greets

J. Local Ground Transportation. When not Local. Purchaser shall provide transportation to and from airport, hotel and venue. A van large enough to transport at least six (6-9) individuals, plus luggage and instruments shall be provided.

K. Hotel. Two (2) nights of hotel for **six (6) DOUBLE NON-SMOKING HOTEL ROOMS** shall be provided. Hotels must be of a nationally recognized chain at least a (2) Two Star Rating.

For Example: Double Tree, Hilton, Marriott Courtyard, Holiday Inn, Hampton Inn, Embassy Suites

- These rooms are to be booked at minimum of two weeks prior to performance.
- Hotel confirmation numbers to be sent to Tour Manager upon booking
- Parking at Hotel must accommodate a Tour Bus and Trailer
- Should be within close proximity of venue (5-7 miles maximum distance)
- If all rooms are not needed, they will be cancelled by tour manager before fees apply
